


How to Disable Windows 10 Automatic Updates


Using Group Policy Editor

In Windows 10, the option to disable automatic updates is invisible by default. You can tweak a setting in Group Policy Editor to make this option show up and prevent your Windows 10 computer from downloading automatic updates. To open Group Policy Editor, go to Start Menu or Cortana and search for gpedit.msc and press enter. Then follow these steps:

1) Click on Computer Configuration, and select Administrative Templates on the following page.




2) Now select **All Settings** and scroll down the list to find the entry that says **Configure Automatic Updates**.

3) Double click on it and select **Disabled**.



That's it, now your computer will not even check to see what Windows 10 updates are available.
